**Registration/Orientation**

- **To register, prospective students MUST use the WDFW Hunter Education on Line Registration System. Go to [www.wdfw.wa.gov](http://www.wdfw.wa.gov) and follow the links to Hunter Education.**
- **On Line Registration for each class opens 2 weeks prior to the Class date.**
- **Registered students not present at 9:00am will be removed from the roster. No walk-ins accepted.**
- All students must bring a printed copy of their On-Line certificate to the class. Students not bringing this document will be refused admittance.
- 10 student maximum per class. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- There is no age limit to take this class. However, our experience has proven that students under 10 years of age are most prone to fail. At a minimum, students must be able to safely handle and fire a youth model 20gauge shotgun.
- A parent or legal guardian must accompany class members that are 17 years old and younger to the class.
- There is not fee for this class. A voluntary donation will gladly be accepted to help defray supply costs.

**Other information**

- **Who is required to take this class?** To purchase a Washington State hunting license, persons born on or after January 1, 1972 must have successfully completed this class.
